

Poster Abstract Submission Guidelines for DISSO ASIA 2014

Society for Pharmaceutical Dissolution Science (SPDS) invites abstracts from researchers and students in the areas of Dissolution rate testing, Release studies and IVIVC related studies for API, conventional and modified release dosage forms, for poster presentation in “DISSO ASIA 2014” to be held in Mumbai on 5th – 6th May 2014. The work of the abstract should not have been presented at any other conference. Please read and follow the guidelines in the preparation of the abstracts. Only one paper per presenting author will be accepted. All presenting authors must be members of SPDS.

Innovative papers will be selected for awards. In case you do not receive an acknowledgement for your abstract submission within 48 hours, you may contact:

Mode of submission: Electronic by e-mail as 'MS word 2007 file attachment to be sent to: - mangal.nagarsenker@spds.in / mala.menon@spds.in

File Format: Abstracts in 'MS word 2007 file format with tables, pictures and graphs embedded within the text of document. (ALL IN BLACK AND WHITE ONLY) are to be submitted.

- The abstracts should :
 1. Be written using simple scientific language to describe recent experiments, innovations and insights.
 2. Include data, new concepts or approaches.
 3. Ensure that all claims and conclusions are supported by data or references, especially those making comparisons to competing products.
- **The deadline for poster abstract submission is by 28th February, 2014**
- Once you have submitted your abstract, you will receive an email acknowledging receipt.
- After review by an expert committee, the acceptance information will be mailed to you by **9st March, 2014**. Reviewers may accept, reject or request modifications, and the authors should submit the modified/corrected abstracts by **17th March, 2014**.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES: -

Your initial submitted manuscript should be two A-4 size pages long, when printed single spaced with one-inch margins using Times New Roman, 12-point font. Tables and figures may be included in this text

Titles, Authors Institutions and Key Words:

On the first page of your paper, the following sections should be included, in Times New Roman 12-point font:

- a) The title of your paper should appear first in “Title Case” (only the first letter of major words and appropriate abbreviations are capitalized.)
- b) The primary author should be underlined, followed by any other authors, using capitalized first letters only. Please provide full first and last names, and the middle initial of all authors. Initials should be followed by a period. Titles and degrees should not be included
- c) The address of the primary author, including their company name (and optionally their department), city, state or province and country, should be listed. If the authors are associated with different institutions, the author(s) and institution(s) should be correctly associated with superscripted Arabic numbers (1, 2, 3, etc.)
- d) No more than 5 **key words** to be included, which will help to quickly access your work from searchable database. Please try to avoid commonly used words like “Dissolution”, “Bioequivalence”, “Pharmacokinetics”, “IVIVC” , since these occur numerous times throughout many poster papers and are not helpful for search purposes.

BODY OF THE TEXT: Please write under the following section headings in the order shown:

Introduction: should be as brief as possible, and should provide background information to understand the research work to be presented by you.

Main Sections: Please use appropriate sub headings to break up your work into appropriate sections, for example, METHODS, DATA ANALYSIS, RESULTS etc. In the end include a CONCLUSIONS section, to interpret the significance of your results.

Use of footnotes is permitted, but should be limited as much as possible.

Acknowledgments: These should be in a separate section immediately following the conclusions. Sources of financial support must be disclosed.

References: All references, including URLs, must be numbered consecutively, in square brackets, in the order in which they are cited in the text and should follow the style given below.

Poster preparation guidelines will be sent along with the acceptance mail, and will also be put up on the SPDS website.
